2. Particulars required to be Gazetted in respect of the winding up of a company.
3. Particulars to be Gazetted under the Interpretation and General Clauses Act Section 8a and the rules thereof:-
4. Particulars to be Gazetted under the Companies (Re-domiciliation) Regulations 1996 (as amended)
 - i. Certificate of Re-domiciliation into Gibraltar pursuant to Sec. 4 (3)
 - ii. Notice that a re-domiciled company has been struck off the register pursuant to Sec 5 (3) (b)
 - iii. Notice of Application for consent to Re-domicile out of Gibraltar pursuant to Sec 7(4)
 - iv. Notice of Cessation pursuant to Sec 10 (3)
