Business Names (Registration) Act

(5) Any former Christian name (or names) or surname of the individual.	
(6) The nationality of the individual.

(9) The other business occupation (if any) of the individual.	
(10) The date of commencement of the business if the business was commenced after the 22nd day of October 1918.	
(11) Any other business name or names under which the business is carried on.

NOTES

NOTE A - This Statement must in all cases be signed by the individual applying for registration and must be sent by post or delivered to the Registrar within fourteen days of commencing to carry on such business.

Failure without reasonable excuse to furnish the required Statement of Particulars within the time specified will in addition to any disability imposed by the Ordinance, entail liability on conviction to a fine not exceeding £5 for every day during which the default continues. Any Statement which contains any matter which is false in any material particular to the knowledge of the person signing it will entail liability on conviction to imprisonment for a term not exceeding three months or to a fine not exceeding £20, or both.

Where the individual applying for registration carries on the business wholly or mainly as Nominees or Trustee of or for another person or other persons or a corporation, or acts as general agent for any foreign firm, the additional particulars specified in Form R.B.N. 2 must also be furnished on such Form and sent by post or delivered to the Registrar in manner and within the times before specified.

NOTE B - Subsection (1) and (2) of Section 2 of the Act provide that a Christian name includes any forenames and that in the case of a peer or person usually known by a British title different to his surname, the title by which he is known shall be substituted in the Act for his surname.

NOTE C - Subsection (3) of Section 2 of the Ordinance provides that reference in the Act to a former Christian name or surname shall not, in the case of natural-born British subjects, include a former Christian name or surname where the name or surname has been changed or disused before the person bearing the name had attained the age of eighteen years; and, in the case of a married woman, shall not include the name or surname by which she was known previous to marriage.
