Failure without reasonable excuse, to furnish the required Statement of any change in the particulars registered within the time specified will, in addition to any disability imposed by the Act, entail liability on conviction to a fine not exceeding £5 for every day during which the default continues and any director, secretary or officer of the corporation who is knowingly a party to the default will be liable to a like penalty. Any statement which contains any matter which is false in any material particular to the knowledge of any person signing it will entail liability on conviction to imprisonment, with or without hard labour, for a term not exceeding three months or to a fine not exceeding £20 or to both such imprisonment and fine..
