Notes:

1. A separate Particulars of Manager page must be completed in respect of each manager and if that manager is not a natural person it must designate one or more natural persons to represent it {Section 5(1)}. A Notice of particulars of the managers, as required by sections 2(2) and 13(1)(a) of the European Economic Interest Grouping Act, 1993 must also be completed in respect of each natural person and be sent to the Registrar.
2. For natural persons his present forename(s) and surname must be given together with any previous forename(s) or surname(s)

In the case of a peer or person usually known by a title different to his surname, "surname" means that title. In the case of a corporation, its corporate name must be given.

A previous forename or surname need not be given if–

(a) in the case of a married woman, it was a name by which she was known before marriage; or

(b) it was changed or ceased to be used at least 20 years ago, or before the person who previously used it reached the age of 18; or

(c) in the case of a peer or person usually known by British title different from his surname, it was a name by which he was known before he adopted the title or succeeded to it.

3. Usual residential address must be given for a natural person. In the case of a corporate body give the registered or principal office.
