liquidator, and must be delivered for registration within 15 days of the passing of the resolution for winding up. You must include a statement of the LLP's assets and liabilities as at the latest practical date before the signing of the

declaration. A member making a declaration under section 362 without having reasonable grounds that the LLP will be able to pay its debts in full within the period specified is guilty of an offence and is liable upon summary conviction to imprisonment for 6 months of a fine at Level 4 on the standard scale, and/or, on conviction on indictment to a term of imprisonment of two years or a fine at level 5 on the standard scale.
