THE END OF PAPER RECEIPTS!

As announced at the end of last year, CHG will as of now issue electronic receipts to users who hold a CHG deposit account and will no longer issue printed receipts to them. All our deposit account users will receive their receipts electronically via email. Authorised signatories of CHG deposit accounts will henceforth authorise their transactions at the Registry by signing on an iPad. Users who do not hold an account with CHG will also have the option of receiving their receipt via email. This is a significant step in CHG's drive towards reducing its carbon footprint. The change will result in a saving of approximately 100,000 printed pages per year.

Removal of the Web Basket for Account Holders.

In order to improve the user experience on the CHG website, the Web Basket has been removed from the e-Registry portal. Up until now, items would be placed in a user's Web Basket and the user would then be required to confirm the purchase of those items placed in the Web Basket. Now, when selecting an item to purchase, users will be prompted to confirm their purchase and will be taken directly to their new purchase in their Personal Folder. Items in the Personal Folder will remain available for download for a period of 30 days. CHG strongly recommend that you download your purchases to your computer or other device for safekeeping.

Company Profile with Pie Chart.

Company profiles are widely used by local professionals. In order to improve the clarity and legibility of our company profiles, headings will be bigger and bolder and a coloured pie chart will be included showing the proportion of the issued share capital held by each of its shareholders. Pie charts will only appear on the company profiles of companies that have one share type and at least two shareholders.

Business Names – 12,500 New Documents Available Online.

The e-Registry service now includes business names. Over 12,500 business name documents are now available for download from the e-Registry. Additionally, users will also have access to Business name profiles via the e-Registry.
